**Freedom of Information Act Request – FOI200820**

Thank you for your information request of 20 August 2020. You requested the following information:

*'the statistics for how many people ICCAN employs, what ICCAN's budget is and on what date ICCAN was formed'*

Although ICCAN, as a new organisation, is not legally yet covered under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, your request has been considered as if we are by applying the same principles. I am writing to confirm that we hold the information that you requested, and would like to offer the below response to your queries.

As context, ICCAN is a non-statutory advisory public body, sponsored by the Department for Transport. It is not a legal entity itself, nor a corporate body, and does not employ its own staff. However, under a framework agreement with the DfT, ICCAN is provided with staff and resource to carry out its functions, as follows:

- ICCAN currently consists of five Commissioners, supported by 14 staff members
- ICCAN's budget for the 20/21 financial year is £1,750,000
- ICCAN was formed in January 2019
